	• White text on a	a standard blue background.	
	• Standard alphabet lettering as specified in the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Canada, or Swiss 924BT.		
	• Lettering not greater than 200 mm in height.		
	• Sign size not greater than what is necessary to accommodate the sign message.		
	• Sign face be retro-reflective to show the same colour by night as by day. ASTM Type IV sheeting material or better is suggested.		
	• Show only the municipal address number, and highway number or road name.
